BACKGROUND OF THE SURVEY



Women and ICT Development Index Survey

Benefits of ICT to Women and Girls

- ❖ SDG 5 on Gender Equality recognizes ICTs as a means to empowerment
- ❖ ICT as a vital tool for women's empowerment
 - ICTs as enabler for women's participation in social and economic development
 - ICTs promote engagement and discourse and help women express their needs and aspirations

BACKGROUND OF THE SURVEY



The WIDI 2020 Survey

- ❖ Overall Aim: Strengthen capacity for ICT statistics through the National ICT Household Survey Series

- ❖ Specific aims of WIDI 2020:
 - Collect data for the UN APCICT PH-Women ICT Frontier Initiative (PH-WIFI) and the UN Asia Pacific Women's Information Network Center (UN APWINC)
 - Collect data on women's access and usage for the DICT GAD Focal Point System, thereby enhancing DICT programs by making them more GAD-responsive
 - To help DICT in identifying interventions towards improving women's ICT access and use, and ICT skills
 - To provide basis for ICT planning and policy formulation focused on women and girls.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SURVEY



The WIDI Survey

- ❖ Technical assistance to the project is provided by the National Planning and Corporate Management Bureau (NPCMB).
- ❖ The survey partner is the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA).
 - PSA said that the WIDI is timely as both the LFS and the Family Income and Expenditure Survey are also going to be conducted, and data items can be merged resulting in a more in-depth analysis of the survey;
 - To be implemented as a rider survey to the 2021 Labor Force Survey (LFS) third quarter, July 2021;
 - MOA is currently being finalized by the PCMD, DICT.

SCOPE OF THE SURVEY



❖ Survey Sample

- Survey sample consists of ~44,000 households with respondents 15 years old and above.

❖ Indicators to be Covered

- Demographics
 - 6 indicators (Age, Sex, Educational Attainment, etc.)
- ICT Access
 - 11 indicators (with/without access to computer, cellphone, etc.)
- ICT Use
 - 4 indicators (usage of internet for education, livelihood activities, etc.)
- ICT Skills
 - 5 indicators (access of information, type of activities, etc.)
- Cybersecurity, Data Privacy, and Online Safety
 - 4 indicators (awareness of cybersecurity and data privacy)
- Digital Economy and E-Commerce
 - 9 indicators (selling and purchasing goods and services online, online/e-money account, etc.)

SURVEY TIMELINE

Pretest II (using CAPI)	June 2021
Finalization of Survey Instruments (Questionnaire, Training Manual)	July-August 2021
Conduct of Trainings	August 2021
Field Operation/enumeration and Supervision	September 2021
Data Processing	October 2021 - February 2022
Submission of Final Survey Report and Data files to DICT	March 2022
