**Houlin Zhao of China** was elected Secretary-General of ITU with 152 votes. 152 countries were present and voting and the required majority was 77.

**Malcolm Johnson of United Kingdom** was elected Deputy Secretary-General of ITU with 104 votes. 168 countries were present and voting and the required majority was 85. Shola TAYLOR of Nigeria received 64 votes.
