The Free Wi-Fi Internet Access in Public Places project, the "PROJECT", of the DOST ICT Office aims to provide as a free public service Wi-Fi Internet access at select public places across the country. From 2016, the PROJECT is expanded in scope and now aims to cover municipalities in <u>all</u> Income Classes.	
1.2.	This tender is for the supply of the " Phase 2 International IP Transport (IPTI2) Service", (the SERVICE), as a 12-month subscription to IPVPN/MPLS connectivity service, composed of a Base bandwidth (please the Item 8 below). The SERVICE shall connect the PROJECT's CORE Component Managed Service (CMS) to the offshore public Internet with 25,000 Mbps (CIR)	
1.3.	The PROJECT's earlier tender for IPTI Service shall herein be considered the "Phase 1 IPTI (IPTI1) Service"	
1.4.	The SERVICE shall generally be composed of three (3) sub-components/sub-services:	
1.4.1.	<i>Domestic IP Backhaul</i> shall be that part/service that provides connectivity from the core routers of IP Core Service of the PROJECT's System Management & Access (SMA) Service to one <u>or more</u> submarine cable landing stations;	

1.4.2.	<i>International IP Backhaul</i> shall be that part that provides connectivity from a submarine cable landing station to another submarine cable landing station abroad, and connection to the IP Transit Service; and,	
1.4.3.	<i>IP Transit Service</i> shall be that part that exchanges IP traffic with other IP transit service providers in other countries.	
1.5.	The above is provided <u>only to clarify service qualifications</u> . A physical implementation corresponding to the composition above should not be understood as a requirement to be sought for this tender. This tender is for a Managed Service only.

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9.1.	1000 Mbps shall equal to 1 Gbps under fault-free performance of the Service;
