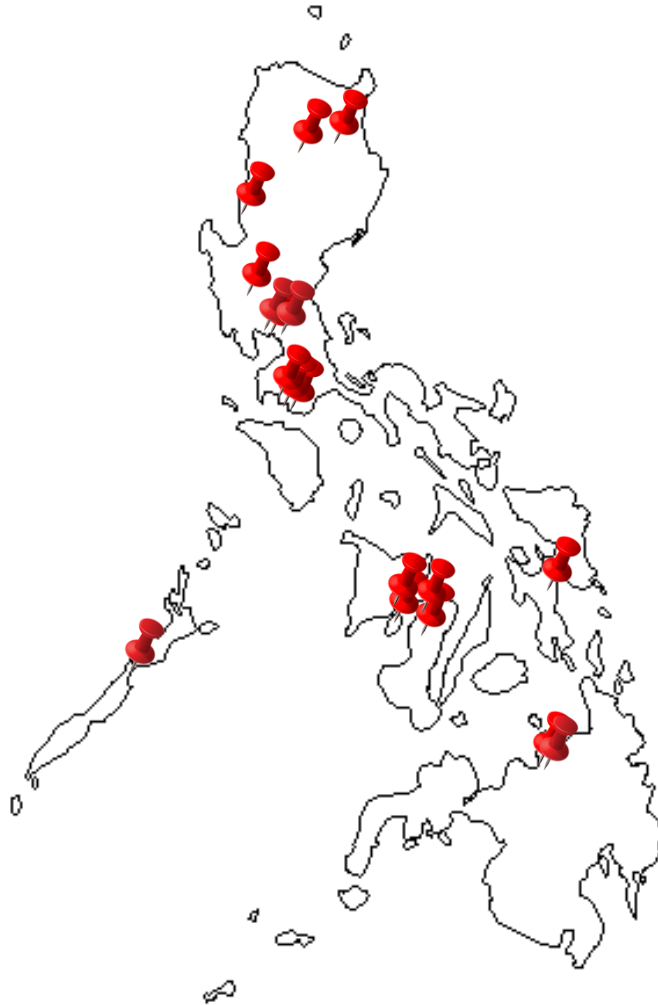

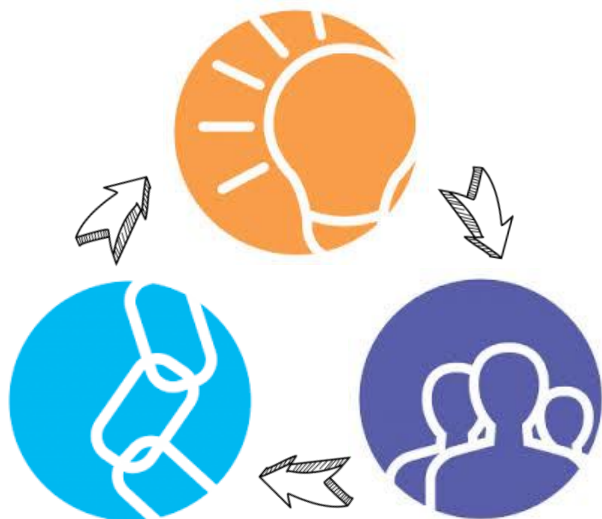

MOU PROVISIONS



Provide competent and certified ICT faculty members as trainers/resource persons

Provide facilities (classrooms, computer laboratories, etc.)

Spearhead promotion of courses and invitation of participants

Provide post-training evaluation

MOU PROVISIONS



Submit reports of trainings conducted

Provide training-related materials

Assign liaison officer/ coordinator

Submit ICT curriculum for DICT accreditation

Undertake joint course development with DICT

ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES



Digital Literacy and other programs

- Conduct of Digital Literacy courses: *Computer and Internet Literacy Course (CILC), Networking Essentials, and Computer Hardware Servicing*
- Apprenticeship program
