	<p>General Overview of the Procurement Project</p> <p>The National Cybersecurity Plan (NCSP) 2022 was created to address the urgency of protecting the nation's Critical Infostructure, Government Networks both Public and Military, Small and Medium Enterprises to Large Businesses and their Supply Chains, and every Filipino using cyberspace. As one of the key strategic initiatives under the protection of government networks, a pool of information security and cybersecurity experts shall be established thru conducting training and certification programs.</p> <p>Understanding the need to equip the Information Technology officers of the government on cybersecurity and information security, a series of training and certification programs shall be carried out. One of these is the Certified Ethical Hacker (CEH) program. CEH is an internationally recognized certification program by the EC-Council that provides understanding of security posture of computer systems and knowledge of penetration tools and techniques. According to EC-Council, a Certified Ethical Hacker is a skilled professional who understands and knows how to look for weaknesses and vulnerabilities in target systems and uses the same knowledge and as a malicious hacker, but in a lawful and legitimate manner to assess the security posture of a target system. The highlight of the program is to develop the hacker mindset and be able to stay ahead of security developments and exploited vulnerabilities.</p> <p>In order to capacitate the government IT personnel with the appropriate skills, competence and credibility in ethical hacking, a training firm shall be engaged to conduct the CEH training and certification exam. The program shall cover a 5-day training and the actual exam.</p>
