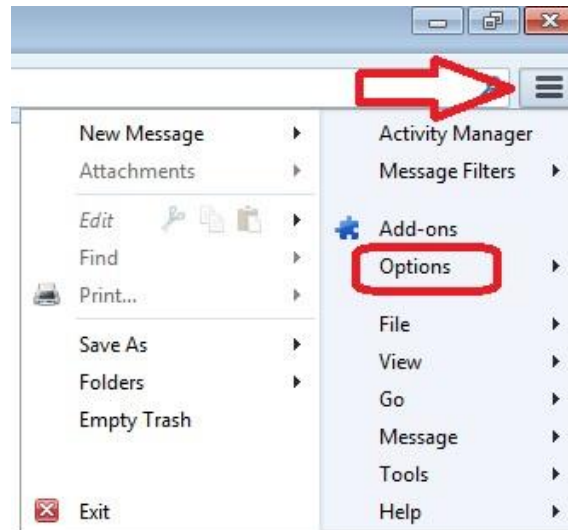


How to delete your digital certificates from Mozilla Thunderbird

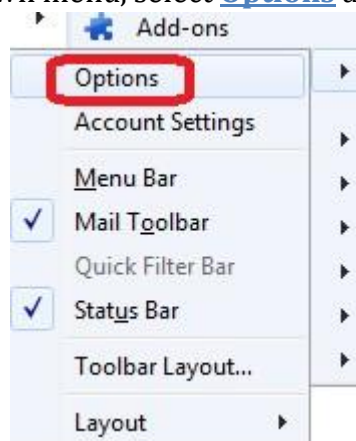
A. Deleting the copies of digital certificates from the Thunderbird Key Store

- I. Launch the Mozilla Thunderbird email client
- II. Click on the Menu icon at the top right corner of the page then select. Option

- III. Under the Options dropdown menu, select Options again.





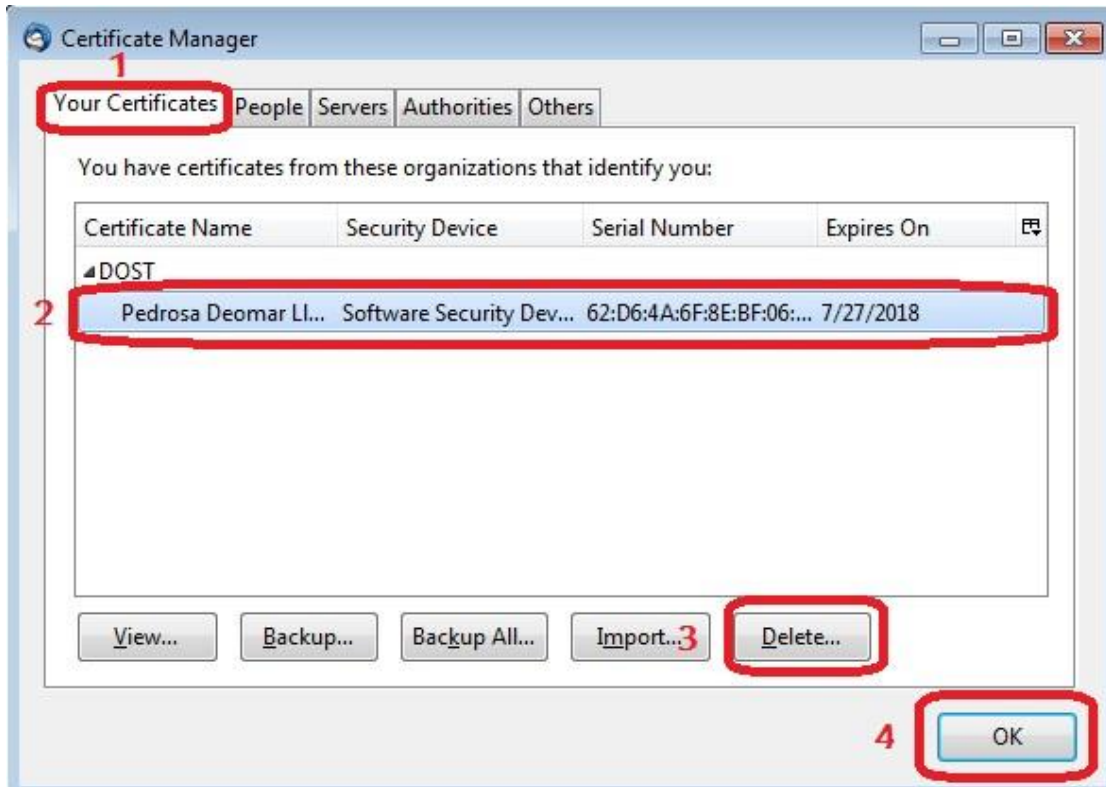
IV. At the [Option page](#)

1. Go to [Advance](#)
2. Go to the [Certificates tab](#)
3. Click on [View Certificates](#)



V. At the [Certificate Manager page](#)

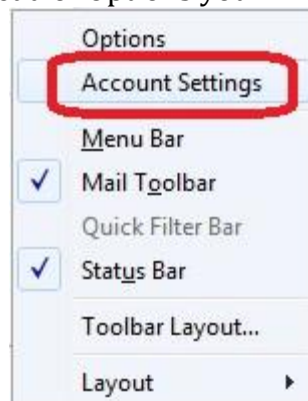
1. Go to the [Your Certificates](#) tab
2. Highlight the certificates you want to remove
3. Click on [Delete](#). A confirmation window will appear, just click on [OK](#) to confirm deletion
4. Click on [OK](#) when finished



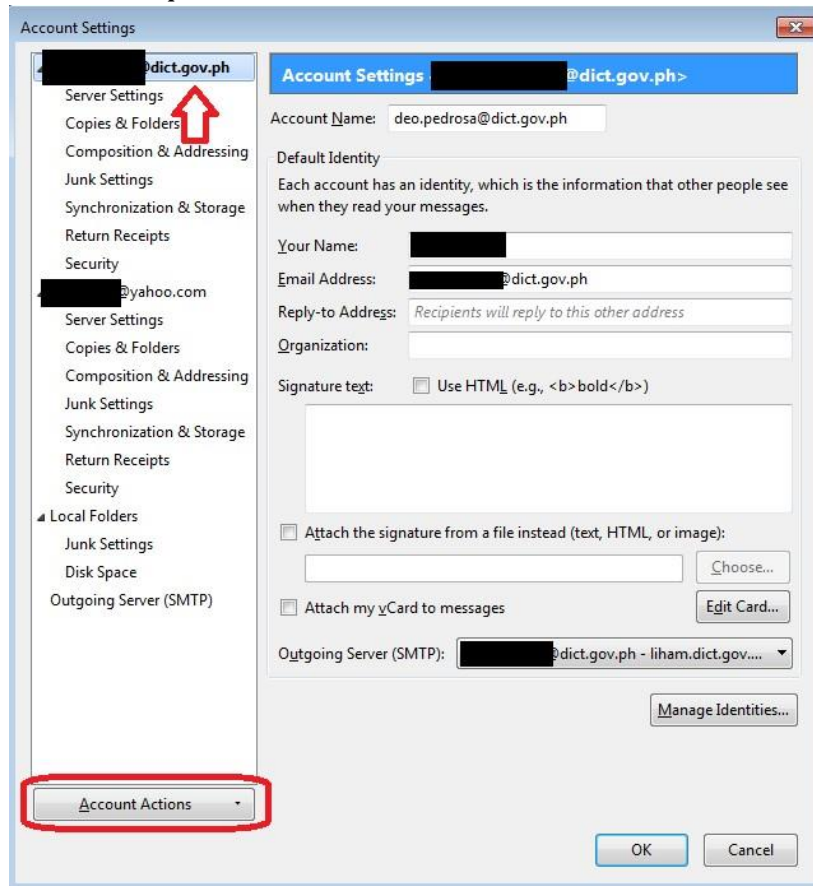
VI. Finally click on OK to close out the [Options](#) window

B. Deleting your email account from the Thunderbird

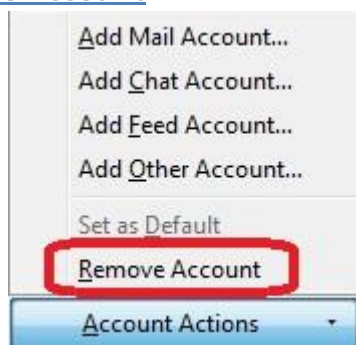
I. Again click on the Menu icon at the top right corner of the page then select Options. This time instead of Options you will select [Account Settings](#)



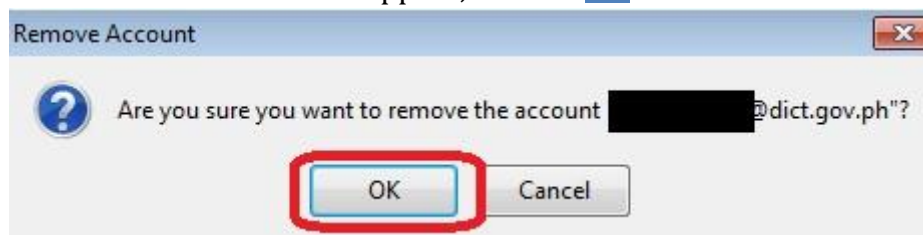
- II. At the account settings window, if you have multiple accounts configured, select the account you want to remove then click on the [Accounts](#) [Actions](#) drop down menu



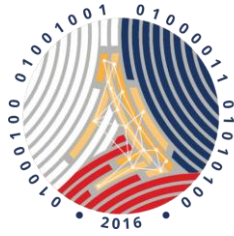
- III. Click on [Remove Account](#)



- IV. A confirmation window will appear, click on [OK](#) to confirm



- V. Finally click on OK to close out the Account Settings window
