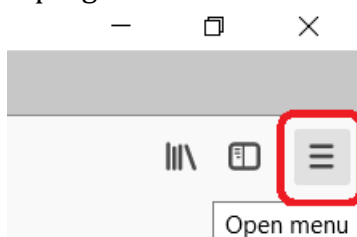


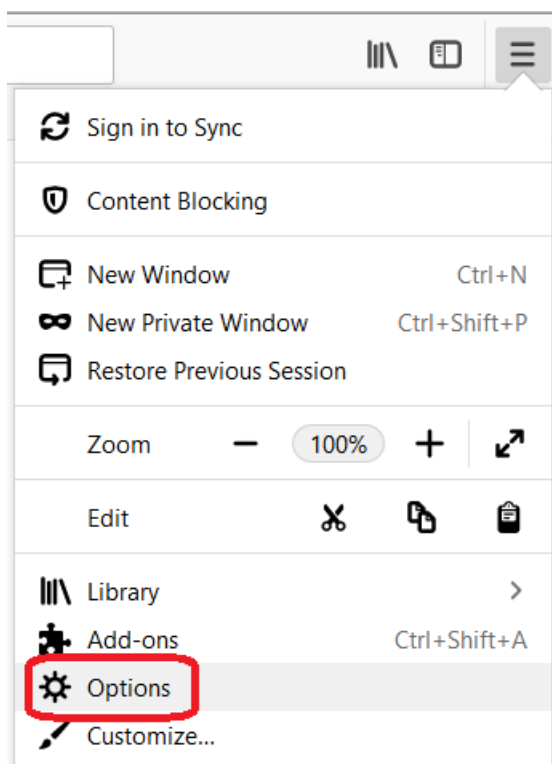


How to install PNPKI Digital Certificate on Firefox

1. Launch your Mozilla Firefox browser. Click on the [Open Menu](#) at the top right corner.



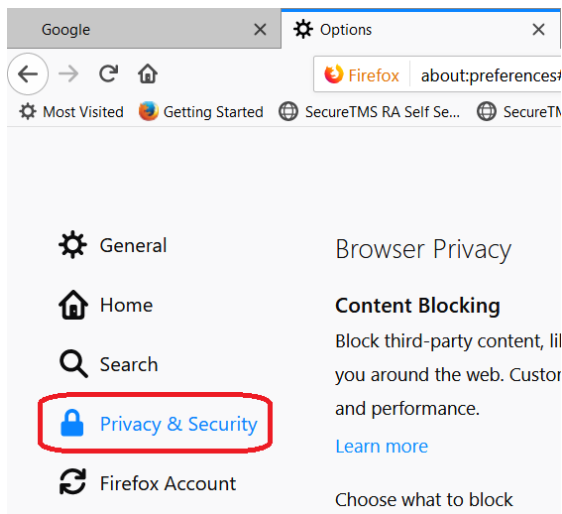
2. Select [Options](#)



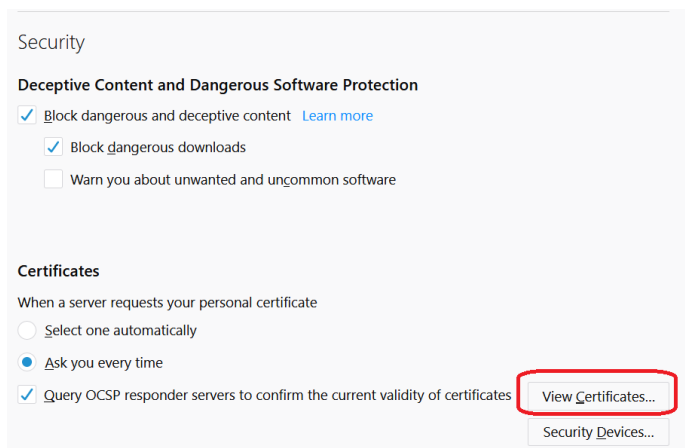

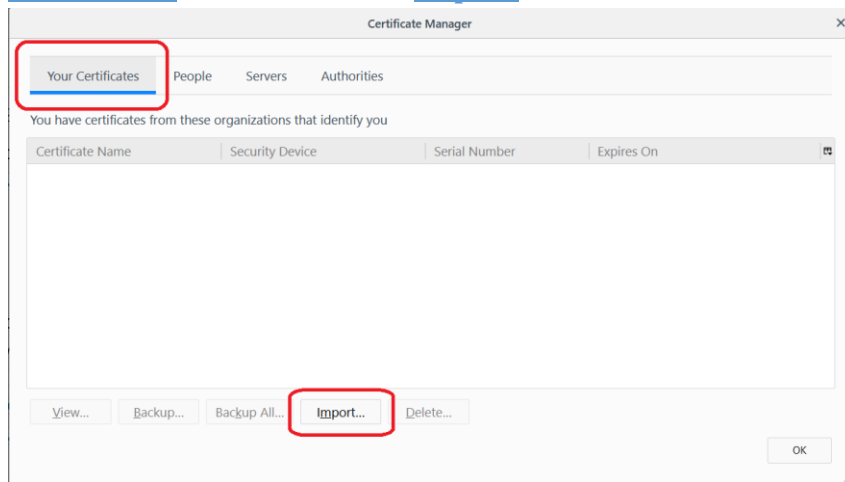
3. A new [Options](#) window will open. Select [Privacy & Security](#)



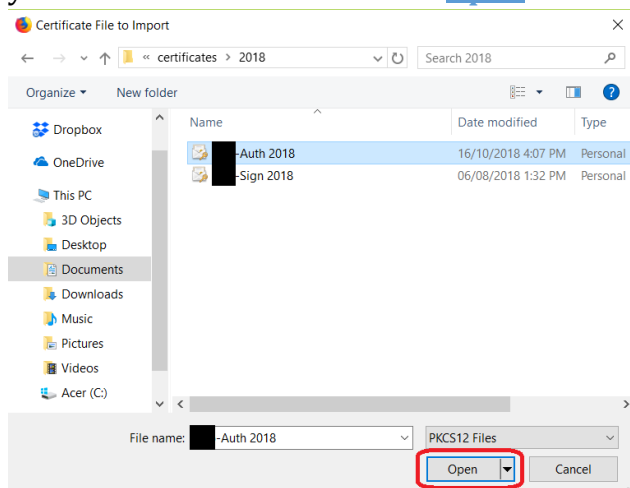
4. Scroll down to the bottom of the page, under the section for [Security](#), look for the [View Certificates](#) button and click on it.



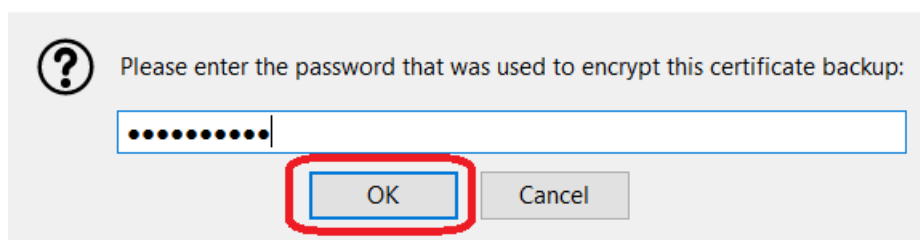
5. The [Certificates Manager](#) window will open. Go to the [Your Certificates](#) tab then click on [Import](#)



6. Go to the folder where your digital certificates are saved. Select the file you need to install then click on [Open](#)

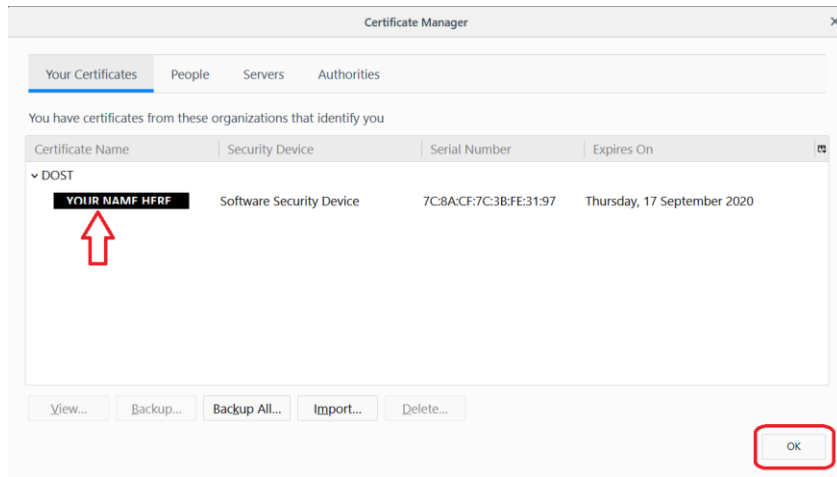


7. Enter the [password](#) you set when first backed up your certificate
